THIRUTHANGAL NADAR COLLEGE A PROFILE

Thiruthangal, a Municipality in Virudhunagar District is located 68 kilometres south of Madurai, very close to Sivakasi, a town well known for safety matches, fire works and printing units. On top of a small hill in Thiruthangal, there are three temples one for Lord Shiva and two others for Lord Muruga and Lord Vishnu. Vishnu is known here as Thirunindra Narayana Perumal and the Goddess as Sengamala Nachiar. This Vaishnavite temple. constructed in 994 A.D. by a native of Thiruthangal, who served as an important Minister to the then Pandva King is one among the 108 sacred places of worship for the vaishnavites. The village had once flourished in agriculture. Later on, the scanty rains in the area and the poor returns from agriculture made the people migrate to urban centres to earn their livelihood, by trade and business. At present, due to the proximity of Sivakasi. Thiruthangal has been witnessing a rapid growth of lucrative business like fire works, match works, printing and other industries

Thiruthangal Hindu Nadar Uravinmurai Dharma Fund was founded in 1920 at Thiruthangal village by a few well-meaning and like-minded elders concerned in the development of the community. Thiruthangal Nadar Bungalow was built on 28th October 1929 by the laudable efforts of Sri. A. Vellaiappa Nadar, the President, Sri.Shanmuga Nadar, the Secretary and Sri. V. Hariharaputra Nadar, the Treasurer of Thiruthangal Hindu Nadar Uravinmurai Dharma Fund. On 9th October 1963 Kalaimagal Primary School was started. Later Girls Higher Secondary School in the name of Sivasubramania Nadar and Guruvammal was started on 21st June 1982. Karuman Karuppanna Nadar Ayyakannammal Matriculation School was founded on 3rd June 1991. More than 6100 students receive quality education and about 216 teachers are employed in these institutions.

Thiruthangal Hindu Nadars, settled in Chennai planned to form an organization for their welfare. They assembled at Backia Bhavanam (located in Tondiarpet, Chennai) of T.A.S. Rathinam & Brothers, on 14th September 1956. Fifty Two persons attended the meeting and established the Chennaivazh Thiruthangal Hindu Nadar Uravinmurai Dharma Fund (a Charitable Fund of Thiruthangal Hindu Nadars living in Chennai). The First Anniversary was held on 15th September 1957. The said fund was registered in 1961 under the Societies Registration Act.

This organization was established owing to the arduous efforts of Thiru.S.Gurusamy Nadar of Thiruthangal, Thiru. P.S. Thangaiah Nadar of Rajapalayam, Thiru. M.S. Ramaiah Nadar of Thiruchirappalli and Thiru. T.A.S. Arumugam of Chennai. In the early periods of the establishment of the Uravinmurai Fund, Thiru. T.A.S. Chelliah served as President and Thiru. Raja K.S.P. Ganesan served as the Secretary. Thiru. S.M. Gurusamy Nadar, Thiru. "Lathas" K.Thangappa Nadar, Thiru.S.Chinnadurai have collectively rendered yeomen service for the growth of the organization in the initial period of its establishment.

The next milestone was in 1968 when the organization purchased a site in G.A. Road, (Now P.A.N. Rajarathinam Road), Washermenpet, Chennai-21. In the said site, a magnificent building Door No.113, named as Thiruthangal Nadar Arangam an epitome of the members unity and solidarity was constructed with the great efforts of Thiru. M.G.Erulangudi Nadar, Treasurer of the Chennaivazh Thiruthangal Hindu Nadar Uravinmurai Dharma Fund who was fondly addressed as "Elam Hariharaputranar". The Arangam was inaugurated on 23rd May 1983 and the following office bearers were elected during the year 1980-1983.

Another turning point is the establishment of "Thiruthangal Nadar Educational Society" as part of Chennaivazh Thiruthangal Hindu Nadar Uravinmurai Dharma Fund on 20th September 1987. This society was registered under Tamil Nadu Registration Act 1975. The first set of office bearers were Thiru.S.M. Gurusamy Nadar as President, Thiru. R.G.Chandramogan as Secretary, Thiru S.Chandran as Asst. Secretary and Thiru. C.Kaniratham as Treasurer. Thiruthangal Nadar Educational Society was merged with Chennaivazh Thiruthangal Hindu Nadar Uravinmurai Dharma Fund on 3rd May 2007.

On 3rd August, 1997 the "Thiruthangal Nadar College" for men was started as an Arts and Science College with Dr. A.P. Kamalakara Rao as the founder Principal. The college functions as a Self-Financing Institution without any grant or aid or subsidies from the Government for its maintenance. The fee collected from the students is comparatively lesser than the Government prescribed fee. There is no collection of donation or other kinds of receipts from the parents. Compared to other self-financing colleges, the college teachers are paid a decent salary. Thiruthangal Nadar College has become a Co-educational Institution from the academic year 2002-2003. Additional facilities are provided for the women students.

The college has been functioning to cater to the needs of a backward area purely with an altruistic ideal of providing higher education at a moderate cost without any discrimination of caste or creed.

At this juncture it would be no exaggeration to state that the committed services of the Executive Committee Members of the Chennaivazh Thiruthangal Hindu Nadar Uravinmurai Dharma Fund are in line with the dedication and dynamic leadership of the then Secretary Thiru. S.M. Subbiah whose efforts complimented and led to the incredible progress of Thiruthangal Nadar College.

In the second chapter of the history of the Chennaivazh Thiruthangal Hindu Nadar Uravinmurai Dharma Fund, the wholehearted commitment of the Executive Committee Members and the then Secretary Thiru. S.M.Subbiah be engraved in golden letters

Presently the strength of the students has come up to 2,626 students (1586 boys and 1040 girls).

Library:

The college has assigned due importance to the Library. The main library of the college serves as an archway to information and functions with a primary mission to serve the academic community with resources. It sprawls over 3,400 sq.ft with well equipped spacious room that readily lends itself for research and learning. It houses over 8,161 books, 50 periodicals, newspapers and journals which are optimally used by the student and teaching community. The Library functions from 8.00.a.m to 3.00 p.m for the benefit of the reading community. Sizable funds are allotted every year towards the purchase of new books. A separate provision is rendered for E-esources with 25 internet enabled computers.

Laboratory:

Six well-equipped fully air-conditioned state-of-art Computer Laboratories and one Digital and Microprocessor Electronics Laboratory (For U.G. and P.G. Courses) are made available for the students. Each student is provided with one computer so as to offer effective practical training and to impart latest knowledge which is tuned to the need of the hour.

Placement:

The placement cell of the college has a vast network and tie-up with many MNC's and organizations and arranges campus interviews. The placement cell functions in a well furnished Air-Conditioned room. The placement cell assists the students in paving a way to good career. The placement cell in collaboration with several IT and corporate sectors trains the students and offers them wide range of opportunities to excel in their lives.

Sports:

Sports and Games form an integral part of TNC's curriculum and due importance is given to the field of sports. The Physical Education Department has a well furnished gym with modern equipments spanning an area of 2,400 sq.ft. and it strives to train the students to be highly talented sportsmen. The college has carefully planned and provided for the students all facilities for athletic events besides Volleyball, Football, Badminton, Basketball, Kabadi, Tennis, Handball, Kho-Kho and Cricket. A Cricket Pitch and a separate net practice pitch were laid during the year 2002-2003. Students are trained and encouraged to participate in many events at many levels so as to bag many prizes and bring glory to the institution which would be an infinite process.

Cafeteria:

The college has a large spacious canteen separately for boys and girls, also a provision for staff members encompassing an area of 7,200 sq.ft. It provides a variety of hygienic refreshment and nutritious food with customized care at moderate prices. Best quality services are offered in a healthy and refreshing atmosphere.

Transport:

At present the college has three buses, one mini bus, three vans and a car.

Auditorium:

An Indoor Auditorium with a capacity of 1,000 seats and a separate block for U.G. and P.G. courses in the first and second floor of the auditorium were constructed. The building is named after S.M. Gurusamy Nadar and G. Valliammal and the auditorium stands in the name of M.G. Erulangudi Nadar and E. Valliammal.

The present infrastructure is optimally used by the beneficiaries of the college. An open air auditorium with a marbled floor with EPI coated roofing and with an accommodation of 2,000 students has been constructed for the students to exhibit their exorbitant skills and to cater to their other needs. Substantial investments have been made to augment existing infrastructure.

An Air-Conditioned Conference Hall named Thiruthangal Gnaniyar S.Arumuga Nadar Meenammal Trust Conference Hall (A/C) holding a seating capacity of 300 and an area of 2,519 sq.ft has been erected to cater to the academic and aesthetic needs of the students and the faculty.

National Service Scheme:

The two units of National Service Scheme (N.S.S.) with a strength of 200 students function in the college. It is under the control of two programme officers, who are conducting the activities of the NSS as per the rules stipulated by the University of Madras. The overall objective of the N.S.S. is the development of the personality of students through community service.

National Service Scheme is basically a field activity and is designed inter-alia, to provide students an opportunity to work by serving the community. N.S.S. students are encouraged to create awareness among the people about various schemes and programmes being implemented by the Government for rural development and to assist local authorities in the identification of beneficiaries. It is the application of education in finding practical solutions to individual and community problems.

Red - Ribbon Club:

Red-Ribbon Club of our college was inaugurated on 25th January 2006 by Dr.M.Vasantha, Dean, Stanley Medical College and 100 volunteers Hospital with the sole purpose of creating awareness on AIDS and prevention of HIV through campaign, slogan writing, etc.

Youth Red Cross:

The Youth Red Cross of the college consisting of 100 volunteers is doing a selfless service to the society by organizing blood donation camps and taking up projects like adult education, collection of medicine for the poor, helping the orphans and the disabled in the hospitals, etc.

Health Care

The college provides medical assistance to the needful. A medical practitioner looks after the emergency needs of the students. The doctor also gives medical and diagnostic advice to Students, Teaching and Non-Teaching Staff.

Space for Rejuvenation

Retiring rooms exclusively for Boys and Girls are made available in the precints of the college for the individuals who need to rest in times of sickness or discomfort.

Parking Lot

The college facilitates a wide parking area exclusively for Boys and Girls. Parallel and secured parking mode with self parking configurations is practiced which enables the students to access the parking individually.

A New Venture:

On 30th April 2004 the Chennaivazh Thiruthangal Hindu Nadar Uravinmurai Dharma Fund had purchased 14.5 grounds of land worth about Rs.1.5 crores at No.1050, T.H.Road, Chennai-600 019 with a plan to establish a school. The dream came true as "Thiruthangal Nadar Vidhyalaya". Presently a full fledged C.B.S.E. School "Thiruthangal Nadar Vidhyalaya" No.67/39, T.H. Road, Thangal, Chennai-19, covering an area of 4.94 ground is functioning in full swing.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

A) ADMISSION AND WITHDRAWAL

- Application for admission to the college is to be made in the prescribed form on or before the last date of submission notified.
 Admitted students must submit their original transfer certificate, statement of marks and other certificates at the time of admission.
- The Applicants will be enrolled and permitted to attend the classes only after the payment of the tuition fees on or before the specified date.
- The second and third year students should pay their fees within the stipulated time period.
- The name of the student will be removed from the rolls if he/she fails to pay the fees within the stipulated period.
- 5. Tuition fee once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- If a student wants to leave the college immediately after joining the course, the student should apply for withdrawal duly countersigned by his/her parent/guardian and they cannot claim refund of fees.
- 7. If a student, after completion of one year or two years of study wants to have transfer certificate in the beginning of next year even without attending the classes, he/she has to pay full fees to the college for the remaining period of the course.
- If a student is expelled from the college due to his/her misbehaviour indiscipline, the information will be given to his/her parent and the transfer certificate will be issued.
- Application for transfer certificate, conduct certificate and other certificates shall be given in advance before leaving the college.

B) CONDUCT

- It is obligatory on the part of each and every student to adhere to the rules and regulations of the college for maintaining good standard, discipline and decorum.
- Students should be present in the campus during the stipulated college timings.
- Students must behave very decently not only within the college campus but also outside the college.
- Students have to conduct themselves in a manner worthy of the college in their dress, demeanour and sense of discipline.
- At the stroke of the first bell in the morning and afternoon the students must be inside their classroom.
- 6. Students should respect the faculty and other superiors.
- Students must stand up when a faculty enters the classroom. They can resume their seats only when they are directed to do so.
- When the Principal, VIP's, Visitors and Members of Management enter the classroom, the students shall rise from their seats and remain standing till they are asked to be seated.
- Students should not leave the classroom before the conclusion of the teaching hour or without the permission of the teacher or until the faculty has left the room or asks the class to disperse.
- 10.Students should avoid using filthy or unparliamentary language.
- 11. Students are expected to behave in a manner befitting the dignity of the college.
- Students should not take part in any political, communal or religious activities.
- 13.No meeting, function or gathering of any such kind should be held within the college campus without the permission of the Principal.
- 14.Eve teasing and ragging are strictly prohibited. As per Government Order students found guilty of these crimes will be fined upto Rs.25,000/- and rigorous imprisonment will be imposed upto 3 years.
- 15.Smoking is strictly prohibited not only in the college campus but also outside the college campus.
- 16.Students who are found using drugs or in a drunken state or under the influence of drugs will summarily be dismissed from the college.
- Loitering, whistling and making noise in the college campus are strictly forbidden.

- An IDENTITY CARD is issued to every student. Students have to wear their ID card in the campus, failing which they will be penalized with a fine of Rs.100/-
- No one is allowed to enter the class without displaying his/her ID card. All students have to wear their ID cards wherever they are in the college campus.
- The ID cards have to be worn by the students during their visit to other colleges and Universities for sports, cultural activities and other academic activites.
- In the event of loss of ID card, students should immediately inform the College office and procure a new one on payment of Rs.50/-
- 22. Students should not visit the canteen during the class hours.
- 23. Obscenity and vulgarity in dressing will not be permitted. Students should dress modestly; the dress should always be in keeping with the place and occasion. They are expected to wear simple, modest and comfortable dress pertaining to the dignity and decorum of the college.
- 24. T-shirts, Jeans and other fancy dresses for male- students, T-shirts and jeans for the female students are prohibited in the campus. All the female students should wear chudidhar with duppatta pinned in V- shape.
- Cameras, Walkmans, Radios and Mobile phones are prohibited in the college campus. If any student has the above said items in the college campus, he/she will be punished with a fine of Rs.1000/-
- 26. Boys and Girls should not talk to each other anywhere in the campus. Anybody violating this rule will be punished and the parents of both the boy and girl will be intimated about this. Even regarding the doubts pertaining to studies, the boys should not ask the girls and vice versa. They should clear their doubts with the faculty concerned in the classroom itself. The books and study materials should not be exchanged between boys and girls.
- 27. The boys should not wear fancy metal bracelets.

- 28. Boys and girls should not wear costly jewels. Girls and Boys are not supposed to carry huge amount into the campus. The boys are not allowed to come with french beard or with any kind of fashionable/ stylish haircuts. The boys and girls should not bleach their hair.
- Students are directed to co-operate with the authorities in keeping the college campus clean and tidy. They should avoid writing on walls and throwing scraps of paper in the college premises.
- 30. Every student should handle the college property with care. Damage caused to college property will be charged to the accounts of the students concerned. If the students, responsible for the damage, could not be identified, the damage caused will be levied from the students.
- Students should park their vehicles only in the space meant for the purpose and must park in an order.
- Change of residence of students/parent/guardian, if any, should be reported forthwith to the Principal.
- 33. Every student shall try to emulate the principled ways of great personalities and aim to achieve success and perfection in all their endeavours. The conduct, character, behaviour and the progress in studies of each student should be satisfactory.
- 34. The college enjoins all students to lead virtuous and disciplined life.

C) ATTENDANCE AND LEAVE

- Every student is expected to attend
 - a) the College on all working days.
 - b) all prescribed hours.
 - all the tests and examinations without fail.
- No student shall absent himself/herself without prior information.
- One should not absent himself/herself to the College without any specific reason.
- All leave letters must be submitted well in advance, to the Head of the Department through the Tutor In-Charge.

- When a student takes leave under unexpected or unavoidable circumstances, he/she must submit the leave letter duly endorsed by the parent/guardian on the next day when he/she attends College.`
- Students who absent themselves for more than three days due to ill -health or other such causes which force bedrest, must submit a medical certificate issued by a registered Medical Practitioner to the Principal within five days from the date of commencement of leave.
- Students not attending any period during the college working days without permission will lose half-a-day's attendance.
- Students who absent themselves during any one of the sessions either forenoon or afternoon without permission will lose the day's attendance.
- The names of students who absent themselves continuously for five or more days without permission will be deleted from the attendance register.
- 10. Attendance will be taken every period.
- If the practice of 'late coming' persists, such students will be subjected to disciplinary action.
- 12. The monthly attendance secured by the students will be informed to the parent/guardian along with their performance in the periodical tests. The parent/guardian must carefully study such reports and advise their wards suitably.
- 13. Minimum of 75% attendance is essential to appear for the University Examinations. Students who have attendance between 65 and 74 percentage will be permitted to appear for the University Examination on payment of condonation Fee of Rs.250/-. Students who have less than 65 percentage of attendance will not be permitted to appear for the University Examination.
- 14. The payment of the University Examination fee by the student does not make the student eligible for payment of condonation on shortage of attendance. The decision of the Principal shall be final in all matters concerning attendance. The reasons for which the condonation may be permitted are long-term illness, major surgery accident and pregnancy with supportive medical documents.

- 15. Stating ignorance of rule-13 or lobbying or giving pressure for required attendance by the students or parents on the eve of the University Examination will be viewed seriously. Hence the students are advised to be very careful in their attendance and the parents are also requested to carefully monitor the same in the periodical attendance report sent to them by the college for their perusal.
- The students who get 100% attendance will be given awards and prizes during College Day function.

D) LIBRARY

- 1. Each student is a member of the Library.
- The Library will be kept open between 8.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. on all working days.
- Students are not permitted to bring their personal belongings inside the Library.
- 4. Silence should be strictly observed in the Library.
- U.G. Student will be issued two library cards and P.G. Student will be issued three library cards. They can borrow books using their cards.
- Whenever a borrowed book is returned, the student must get back his/her library card. Otherwise, the student will be held responsible for the books borrowed from the library.
- In case the Library Card is lost, the loss must be immediately reported to the Librarian.
- Students who have lost the Library card will forfeit the right to borrow books and will have to pay Rs.100/-
- The Students can retain the borrowed books for not more than 10 days, if the same book/books is/are needed beyond 10 days, then they must renew the book (s) subject to the condition that there is no demand for such book(s) from other student(s).

- The Librarian has the right to call back any book lent to the students, at any time before the due date of return.
- Defaulters who fail to return the books on time, will be fined at the rate of Rs.2/- per day per book.
- Absence of the student will not be entertained as a reason for not returning the books.
- The list of students, who fail to return the books on the due date, will be put up on the notice board.
- 15. The entire fine amount due to the Library must be paid in the library itself, at the end of the semester. otherwise the Hall Ticket will not be issued.
- 16. As soon as the books are received, students must examine the same very carefully. Defects, if found, must be reported to the Librarian. Otherwise the student will be held responsible for it.
- Students must avoid writing notes/ underlining on the pages of the books. Every page will be examined when the student returns the books.
- Students must keep/handle the books with care. In case a book is lost/ damaged, the cost of the book will be recovered from them.
- The Librarian will not issue books to the students, who fail to adhere to the rules and regulations of the Library.
- 20. Dictionaries and reference books will not be issued on loan.
- Students must surrender the Library cards at the time of leaving the college.
- 22. Magazines and journals must be handled with utmost care.
- Students may approach the Librarian/Tutor-In-Charge/H.O.D./ Principal in case of any difficulty in using the facilities of the Library.

E) TESTS & EXAMINATIONS

- The departments would conduct daily and periodical tests for the students in various disciplines.
- The college will conduct mid-semester and model examinations each semester based on University Examination pattern.
- Attendance is compulsory for all the students in all these examinations.
- A fine of Rs.50/-for each paper in the mid-semester examination and a fine of Rs. 100/- for each paper in the model examination will be imposed on the absentees to these tests.
- The performance of the students in such tests and examinations will be taken into consideration in taking final decision on allowing the student to the University Examination.

F) PHYSICAL EDUCATION

- The Department of Physical Education will be under the direct control of the Principal. He will appoint a Lecturer as the member-in-charge of the Physical Education Department.
- The Director of Physical Education will carry on the activities of the Department under the direction and guidance of the Principal.
- The teams will be selected under the direction of the Principal and the Physical Director.
- The Physical Director will provide gym, weight-lifting instruments, and the training tools and those will be available for exercise after the college working hours on all working days.

G) MANAGEMENT SCHOLARSHIPS

In recognition and appreciation of the diligence and intelligence of our students the esteemed College Management offers the following scholarships:

The students who have secured above 1000 marks in HSC Examination are eligible for a Merit Scholarship. On payment of their fees during admission 50% of their fees will be refunded as Merit Scholarship through Chennaivazh Thiruthangal Hindu Nadar Uravinmurai Dharma Fund.

The diligent students who procure 80% and above in their University Semester Examination are eligible for a Merit Scholarship. In recognition of their arduous efforts, on paying their fees 50% of their fees will be refunded as Merit Scholarship through Chennaivazh Thiruthangal Hindu Nadar Uravinmurai Dharma Fund.

The College also offers Sports Scholarship for students who have won laurels in state-level games. On paying their fees, 50% of their fees will be refunded through Chennaivazh Thiruthangal Hindu Nadar Uravinmurai Dharma Fund as Sports Scholarship.

The students who have won championships in district-level are also eligible for the Sports Scholarship. On the payment of their fees, 25% of their fees will be refunded through Chennaivazh Thiruthangal Hindu Nadar Uravinmurai Dharma Fund as Sports Scholarship.

In order to be eligible for the Sports Scholarship the state-level champions are supposed to participate and win in university level games and university B-zone games.

THE GOVERNMENT OF INDIA SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS:

The Hindu Schedule Caste and Schedule Tribe students whose parents' annual income is less than Rs. 2,00,000 (Rupees Two Lakhs Only) are eligible for the scholarship offered by the Government ofIndia.

H) N.S.S, Y.R.C, R.R.C

- Students who have already participated in R.S.P scouts & Guide, N.C.C, N.S.S in school level will be given preference for joining N.S.S.
- Students must not involve in any political activity or party politics or any kind of communal activity.
- Each student must pay an annual subscription of Rs. 50/- at the time of Joining.
- Activities like the collection of funds, canvassing for any unapproved activities, meetings or group activities etc., are strictly prohibited.
- Students who completes 120 hours of service during 1st and IInd year will be given the service certificate after the completion of course.
