Worked for women empowerment

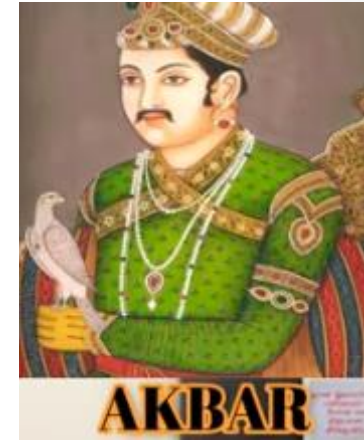
Built roads for the people

- Local taxes

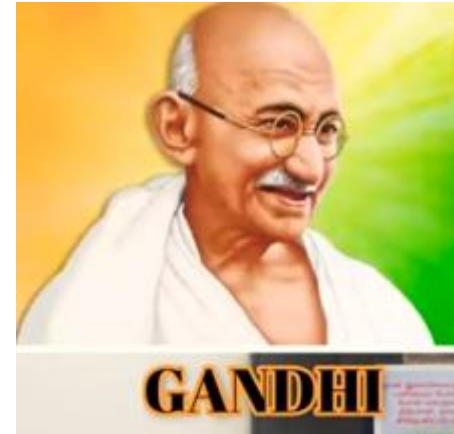








- UPPER CASTE MEN WERE ALLOWED TO MARRY EVEN 100 WOMEN
