ELIGIBILITY

B.B.A., B.Com., B.Com. (CS), B.Com. (ISM), B.Com. (Accounting & Finance), B.Com. (Bank Management) and B.Com. (Computer Appli.)

To join in any one of the above courses, the student should have passed the HSC Examination in the Academic Stream or in the Vocational Stream, conducted by the Government of Tamil Nadu or an Examination accepted as equivalent to there of by the syndicate of the University of Madras.

B.Sc. (Computer Science), B.C.A., & B.Sc. (Software Applications)

Students seeking admission to these three courses should have passed Mathematics, Physics & Computer Science or the group 1 subjects of HSC Examination, consisting of Mathematics, Physics & Chemistry or Computer Science and other three subjects.

B.Sc. (Mathematics)

Candidates should have studied Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and any other subject as the fourth paper or they must have passed Mathematics and any other three subjects in the Higher Secondary Examination.

In the selection process preference will be given to the candidates who have passed the HSC Examination in the first attempt.

CERTIFICATES REQUIRED FOR ADMISSION

At the time of Interview the following certificates in original should be submitted by the applicant.

- ❖ Transfer Certificate.
- ❖ Conduct Certificate issued by the institution where last studied.
- ❖ Marks Certificate in original and a set of Xerox Copies of the same.
- ❖ Community Certificate in Original in case of S.C., S.T., M.B.C., D.N.C. and B.C., candidates. One xerox copy of the same must be submitted.
- ❖ A Medical Fitness Certificate issued by any registered medical practitioner. The registration number of the medical practitioner must be specified in the certificate.
- ❖ Income Certificate in original in case of S.C., S.T. M.B.C., D.N.C. and B.C., candidates. One Xerox copy of the same must be submitted.
- ❖ Physically handicapped applicants must submit a certificate issued by a competent authority.
- ❖ The Applicants who are the children of Ex-Service men of Tamilnadu origin must produce the relevant certificates issued by the competent authority.
- ❖ Certificate of distinction in sports / games (District, Zone, State & National Level) and other extra curricular activities, special courses, camps attended etc., if available may be presented.
- ❖ Three recent passport size colour photos of the Applicant are to be submitted with details like name, application number, course applied on the reverse side. A stamp size photo should also be submitted for the I.D. Card.

INFRASTRUCTURE

Thiruthangal Nadar College is located in a sprawling ten acre campus wholly owned by Chennaivazh Thiruthangal Hindu Nadar Uravinmurai Dharma Fund. The 1,22,630 sq.ft., constructed area with two floors, shelters the well - ventilated and well furnished classrooms with all the infrastructure required for the ease and comfort of the students. Development of infrastructure and facilities is an ongoing process and it never ceases in Thiruthangal Nadar College.

A new building in addition to the existing blocks to encompass a new library, canteen, gym, a room exclusively for indoor games and many more facilities to cater to the needs of the students has been constructed recently.



CLASS ROOM

Spacious classrooms with natural and artificial ventilation can easily seat more than 70 students each are built in good number. They are provided with furniture of quality and comfort. Along with the necessary electrical fittings, each room is provided with the glass-cased notice board exclusively to display the information to the class. The class rooms are designed in a way to promote inter personal relationship between faculty and students.

FACULTY

Though the College has only 18 years of standing, it has caught the attention of the general public. The reputation the college enjoys, is largely due to the commitment of the faculty. Their devotion, excellence and efficiency are manifested not only in the class rooms but also in all activities encompassing the campus. Their erudition, rich talent and genial nature provide confidence and acceptance necessary for the right dissemination of information. Their quest for knowledge also keeps them updated and helps them to keep the class in perfect control.

LABORATORIES

The College takes credit of possessing Six fully equipped computer laboratories which are fully air conditioned. The digital and micro processor lab possess several digital kits and micro processor kits. Four labs are allotted to U.G. Students and the other two are exclusively used by the Post - Graduate students.



LIBRARY

Library is a backbone to an Educational Institution. TNC Library is adequate and efficiently managed. The college main library which serves as an archway to information, functions with a primary mission to serve the academic community with resources. It sprawls over 8410 sq.ft with well equipped spacious premises that readily lends itself for research & learning .To instil e-learning in students, a special cabin accomodating 20 systems with net connectivity has been provided within the library. It houses over 8161 books which are optimally used by the student & teaching community. The library functions from 8.00 a.m to 3.00 p.m for the benefit of the reading community. The Library is fully automated and maintained by well - qualified computer Literate staff. Due importance is given towards modernization of library and information services. The management ungrudgingly provides sufficient annual funds for the inclusion of books.



AUDITORIUM

The College Auditorium is beautifully designed and thoughtfully built. The 7,500 sq.ft., College Auditorium is in the ground floor with the capacity of 900 seats.

CANTEEN

The college has a large spacious canteen exclusively for Boys and Girls, encompassing an area of 7200 sq.ft It provides a variety of refreshment and hygienic food with customized care at moderate prices. The administration closely monitors the function of the canteen.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Sports and Games form an integral part of TNC'S Curriculum. The Physical Education Department has a well furnished gym with modern equipments spanning an area of 2400 sq.ft and it strives to train the students to be highly talented sportsmen.

There are well-laid play fields for sports of various disciplines in the College. A new cricket pitch has been laid for the lovers of cricket and cricket nets have also been provided for practice. The College conducts special summer coaching camps for cricket at nominal fees. Students of TNC are champions in Divisional and University Tournaments in select disciplines. They have carved a niche for themselves in Cricket, Volley Ball, Badminton, Kabadi, Weight Lifting, Body Building and Athletics. The college provides enough encouragement and motivation for the young sportsmen to hone their skills and keep the flag of the college flying high. There is a gymnasium in the campus, to keep the students physically fit. Sports for women students are also equally encouraged in the campus.



PLAY GROUND

The boys are provided with a playground spanning an area of 4 acres and there is a playground exclusively for girls covering an area of 1 acre to practice and participate in sports and games.



HEALTH CARE

The college provides medical assistance in campus a medical practitioner looks after the emergency needs of the students. The doctor also gives medical and diagnostic advice to students, Teaching and Non-Teaching staff.

SPACE FOR REJUVENATION

Retiring rooms exclusively for Boys and Girls are made available on the precincts of the college for the individuals who need to rest in times of sickness or discomfort.

REST ROOM FOR WOMEN

There are decent rest rooms maintained in an hygienic manner for the women students to rest and recoup.

DRESS CODE

TNC lays stress on the students to be well groomed. Students should always be presentable and elegantly dressed. They are advised to wear simple, neat and dignified clothes. They should always keep in their minds that they are coming to the temple of learning and extend due regard by following formal dress code.



TRANSPORT FACILITIES

Majority of the students come to college by their own means. A small percentage depend upon the public transport, travelling to Kaviarasu Kannadasan Nagar bus terminus. The roads are neatly laid and facilitate a pleasant walk to and from the bus terminus. The College has its own buses to pick staff and girl students from different points. The college provides this service on subsidized rates.

PARKING LOT



The college facilitates a wide parking area exclusively for Boys and Girls. Parallel and secured parking mode with self parking configurations are practiced which enables the students to access the parking individually.



PLACEMENT CELL

Thiruthangal Nadar College's yet another speciality is an active placement cell which works in full swing to equip our students to face the challenges of the global market. Apart from academic coaching, the college concentrates in developing the I.Q.level, personality and communication skills of the students through seminars, workshops, guest lectures, etc., to help them fare well in the interviews.



SEMINARS



There is a different style of teaching in Thiruthangal Nadar College. Classroom atmosphere is made lively and the students are encouraged to be active participants in the process of learning instead of remaining passive receivers of information. The students participate in the learning process and express themselves confidently. There are plenty of opportunities for them to participate in Seminars, Symposia and Academic Conferences. Students comfortably cultivate fluency of thought and expression by such academic and intellectual exercises.

TUTORIAL SYSTEM

TNC helps the students to identify their strengths and weaknesses by drawing them into a Tutorial System. Arrear students are introduced to special coaching classes which will equip them to clear all their papers and get their degrees at the earliest. Faculty Members work with enthusiasm and dedication in the interest of the students' welfare and carefully monitor the progress of students under their charge.
