INFRASTRUCTURE

PERUNTHALAIVAR KAMARAJAR ARANGAM



As a mark of respect to Perunthalaivar Kamarajar, a well structured open auditorium with a sturdy shelter, Perunthalaivar Kamarajar Arangam was erected in an excellent manner. This sprawls over an area of 10,000 sq.ft, equipped with the state of the art facilities to fulfill the artistic needs of the students. To cater to the academic needs of the students an A/C Conference Hall has also been constructed.

CLASS ROOM

Spacious class rooms with natural and artificial ventilation which can easily seat more than 70 students each, are built in good number. They are provided with furniture of quality and comfort. In addition to the necessary electrical fittings, each room is provided with the glass-cased notice board exclusively to display the information to the class. The class rooms are designed in such a way to promote inter - personal relationship between faculty and students.

FACULTY

The college has caught the attention of the general public in its 19 years of standing. The reputation the college enjoys, is largely due to the commitment of the faculty. Their devotion, excellence and efficiency are manifested not only in the class rooms but also in all activities encompassing the campus. LABORATORIES

The College takes credit of possessing six fully equipped computer laboratories which are fully air-conditioned. Four labs are allotted to U.G. Students and the other two are exclusively used by the P.G. students. The digital and micro processor lab possesses several digital kits and micro processor kits.



LANGUAGE LAB

Enhancing the skills of the students who step into the threshold of Thiruthangal Nadar College is the prime motto of the institution. In this regard to enhance the communication skills of the students a modern language lab has been set up, which offers an interesting learning experience to the students.

LIBRARY

Library is the backbone to an Educational Institution. The central Library of the college is adequate and efficiently managed. It serves as an archway to information and functions with a primary mission to serve the academic community with resources. It sprawls over a 8,410 sq.ft well equipped spacious premises that readily lends itself for research & learning .To instil E-learning in students, a special cabin accomodating 20 systems with internet facility has been provided within the library. It houses over 8,161 books which are optimally used by the student & teaching community.

The library functions from 8.00 a.m to 3.00 p.m for the benefit of the reading community. The Library is fully automated and maintained by well - qualified computer literate staff. Due importance is given towards modernization of library and information services. The management magnanimously provides sufficient annual funds for the inclusion of books.



AUDITORIUM

The M.G.Erulangudi Nadar and E.Valliyammal Auditorium is beautifully designed and thoughtfully built. The 7,500 sq.ft., College Auditorium is in the ground floor with the capacity of 1,000 seats.

CANTEEN

The college has a large spacious canteen exclusively for Boys and Girls, encompassing an area of 7,200 sq.ft. It provides a variety of refreshment and hygienic food with customized care at moderate prices. The administration closely monitors the function of the canteen.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Sports and Games form an integral part of the college's curriculum. The Physical Education Department has a well furnished gym with modern equipments spanning an area of 2,400 sq.ft and it strives to train the students to be highly talented sportsmen.

There are well-laid play fields for sports of various disciplines in the college. A new cricket pitch has been laid for the lovers of cricket and cricket nets have also been provided for practice. The College conducts special summer coaching camps for cricket at nominal fees. Our students are champions in Divisional and University Tournaments in select disciplines. They have carved a niche for themselves in Cricket, Volley Ball, Badminton, Kabadi, Weight Lifting, Body Building and Athletics. The college provides enough encouragement and motivation for the young sportsmen to hone their skills and keep the flag of the college flying high. There is a gymnasium in the campus, to keep the students physically fit. Sports for women students are also equally encouraged in the campus.



PLAY GROUND

The boys are provided with a playground spanning an area of 4 acres and there is a playground exclusively for girls covering an area of 1 acre to enable them to practice and participate in sports and games.



SPACE FOR REJUVENATION

Retiring rooms exclusively for Boys and Girls are made available in the precincts of the college for the individuals who need to rest in times of sickness or discomfort.

REST ROOM

There are decent rest rooms maintained in an hygienic manner for the students to rest and recoup.

DRESS CODE

The college lays stress on the students to be well groomed. Students should always be presentable and elegantly dressed. They are advised to wear simple, neat and dignified clothes. They should always keep in their minds that they are coming to the temple of learning and extend due regard by following formal dress code.

TRANSPORT FACILITIES



Majority of the students come to college by their own means. A small percentage depend upon the public transport, travelling to Kaviarasu Kannadasan Nagar bus terminus. The roads are neatly laid and facilitate a pleasant walk to and from the bus terminus. The college has its own buses to pick staff and girl students from different points.

PARKING LOT



The college facilitates a wide parking area exclusively for Boys and Girls. Parallel and secured parking mode with self parking configurations are practised which enables the students to access the parking individually.



PLACEMENT CELL

Yet another speciality of the college is an active placement cell which works in full swing to equip our students to face the challenges of the global market. Apart from academic coaching, the college concentrates in developing the I.Q.level and the personality and communication skills of the students through seminars, workshops, guest lectures, etc., to help them to fare well in the interviews. The placement cell provides Pre-Placement training to enhance the communication and interpersonal skills of students and groom them into productive beings who can contribute to the development of the society. Many on and off campus recruitment drives were conducted by the placement cell.



SEMINARS

- ✦ Tuition Fees, Spl. Fees & Miscellaneous Fees must be paid every semester. (6 semesters)
- ✦ Caution Deposit must be paid at the time of admission only.
- ✦ Special Fee is collected along with the Tuition Fee as per the Government, University and Management norms.
- ✦ **Odd Semester Fee** must be paid within **June** and **Even Semester Fee** within **October**.

All fees, including the special fees will not be refunded if a student leaves the college for any reason in the middle of the course. Any request for the extension of time for payment of fees will not be considered and the admission granted will be cancelled.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Admitted students belonging to S.C and S.T communities are eligible to apply for different kinds of scholarships offered by the Government of Tamilnadu and the Government of India, provided they satisfy the conditions prescribed by the authorities concerned.

CERTIFICATES REQUIRED FOR ADMISSION

At the time of Interview the following certificates in original should be submitted by the applicant.

- ✦ Transfer Certificate.
- ✦ Conduct Certificate issued by the institution where last studied.
- ✦ Marks Certificate in original and a set of Photo Copies of the same.
- ✦ Community Certificate in original in case of S.C., S.T., M.B.C., D.N.C. and B.C., candidates. One photo copy of the same must be submitted.
- ✦ A Medical Fitness Certificate issued by any registered medical practitioner. The registration number of the medical practitioner must be specified in the certificate.
- ✦ Income Certificate in original in case of S.C., S.T., M.B.C., D.N.C. and B.C., candidates. One photo copy of the same must be submitted.
- ✦ Physically handicapped applicants must submit a certificate issued by a competent authority.
- ✦ The Applicants who are the children of Ex-Service men of Tamilnadu origin must produce the relevant certificates issued by the competent authority.
- ✦ Certificate of distinction in sports / games (District, Zone, State & National Level) and other extra curricular activities, special courses, camps attended etc., if available may be presented.
- ✦ Three recent passport size colour photos of the Applicant are to be submitted with details like name, application number and the course applied for, on the reverse side.

NOTE

- ✦ **All original certificates should be presented at the time of interview.**
- ✦ **If selected, all originals will be retained by the college except community certificate.**
- ✦ **Candidates are advised to take adequate number of photo copies of their certificates.**
